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CLUB RULES

The Fairhaven Golf Club expects a high standard from all who play golf and you are asked to ensure that you and your guests are aware of the following dress rules:

Dress Code – Clubhouse

- a. Shorts are **NOT** permitted in any area except the changing rooms and the main corridor.
- b. All shirts will have a collar, sleeves, and be free of advertising apart from the accepted discreet manufacturers logo.
- c. Sweaters should also be free from advertising etc. as in 'b' above.
- d. Crew necked sweaters may not be worn without a shirt.
- e. Denim jeans or other denim wear, tracksuits, plimsolls, trainer shoes or similar are **NOT** acceptable wear.
- f. Golf shoes must **NOT** be worn in any clubhouse area other than the changing rooms.
- g. Outdoor clothing may not be worn in any social area and must be hung in the appropriate spaces provided – outside the social areas.
- h. Jackets and ties **MUST** be worn in the dining room after 6.00 p.m.

Dress Code – Course

All players must be properly attired for the game of golf including approved golf footwear.

The following conditions will apply:

- a. Properly tailored shorts may be worn provided that they are no shorter than three inches above the knee. Shorts may not be worn in any area of the clubhouse.
- b. *White* sports socks or knee length stockings may be worn with shorts.
- c. Denim jeans or other denim wear, tracksuits, sweat shirts, shirts without collars and sweaters without a collared shirt **are not acceptable wear on the course.**
- d. Plus Twos or Fours are acceptable but ordinary trousers tucked into socks are not permitted.
- e. Shirts must not be worn outside trousers.
- f. Similar standards are expected from ladies.
- g. No mobile phones should be used on the course.

Mobile telephones may be used discreetly on the car park and in the changing rooms but must be switched off in any other area of the clubhouse and course.

Visitors' vehicles must be parked in the visitors' car park, which is clearly sign-posted along the main drive.
